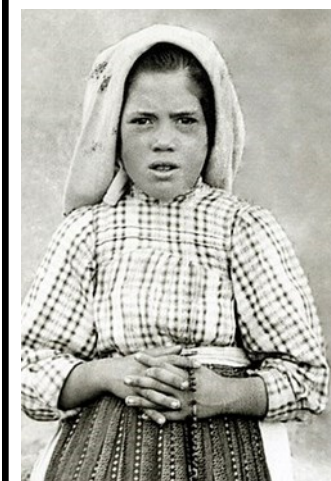
AMERICA NEEDS FATIMA. *America Needs Fatima* (ANF) is a special campaign to spread the message of Fatima in the United States. The goal of America Needs Fatima is to win the heart and soul of America for Mary by spreading Our Lady's Fatima message and promoting devotion to Her Immaculate Heart. America urgently needs the prophetic messages of Our Lady at Fatima. Above all, America needs a clear direction, a great purpose, and the means to achieve it. The admonitions, requests, and warnings of Mary Most Holy can rightly be called a heaven-sent survival manual.

What did Our Lady ask us to do? 1) Consecrate Ourselves to Her; 2) Wear the Brown Scapular; 3) Pray the Rosary Daily; 4) Offer Daily Prayers and Sacrifices; 5) Make the First Satur-

day Devotion.

"Calls "from the Message of Fatima, also known as "Appeals" from the Message of Fatima, is a 2000 book written by Sister Lucia de Jesus Rosa de los Santos, the last surviving seer of the apparitions of Our Lady of Fátima in 1917.

Finding herself inundated with constantly repeated questions concerning the Marian Apparitions that occurred in Fátima, Portugal, and the visionaries, the message they received and the reason for some the requests contained in that message, and feeling that it was beyond her to reply individually to each questioner, Sister Lúcia asked the Holy See for permission to write a text in which she could reply in general to the many questions that had been put to her. This permission was granted, hence the present



work titled in English language: "Calls" or "Appeals" from the Message of Fatima.

This book is, in effect, a long letter, written entirely by Sister Lúcia and addressed by her to all those who have written to her concerning their doubts, questions, and difficulties, and their desire for greater fidelity in living up to what was asked for from Heaven in the Cova da Iria. https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Calls_from_the_Message_of_Fatima <https://www.americaneedsfatima.org/>

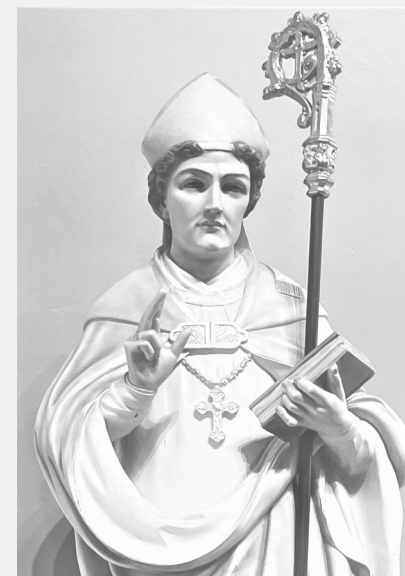
